

Job Description for TIG Welder/Fabricator

- Weld, fabricate, and repair metal and other weldable material by applying appropriate welding techniques.
- Responsible for full-service welding needed for assembly of cars.
- Responsible for welding parts for new projects and inventory.
- Maintain a clean and well-organized work area.
- Responsible for maintaining job equipment in the shop that is used in fabrication work for body and parts production.
- Interprets blueprints, specifications, diagrams, or schematics to determine appropriate welding process.
